GREETINGS, PEACE, and APOSTOLIC BLESSINGS, in the name of the Very Holy PANTOKRANTOR, the KRISTOS SOTHER, their Mediator, and the SOPHIA HAGION, for the unity of all in the Splendor of the Divine Pleroma. AMEN.

We, +REGINALD M. FREEMAN, in ecclesia, TAU PHOSPHOROS, by the Grace of GOD, Steward of the Apostolic Filiation according to EVODUS, First Patriarch of the Church of ANTIOCH, consecrated by Peter the Apostle,

DO HEREBY ANNOUNCE

That on Thursday, December Eleventh, Two Thousand Fourteen A.D., Feast of Pope Saint Damasus I, in the presence of a Gnostic Christian Assembly at a private chapel located in Sumner, Illinois, by virtue of the Episcopal powers granted to Us by the succession of the Apostolic See of Antioch, in Syria, having invoked with Our prayers the SOPHIA HAGION, The Divine Holy Ghost, We, +REGINALD M FREEMAN, in ecclesia, TAU PHOSPHOROS, did impose Our hands upon

We have consecrated him with the Holy Myron, in the title of Bishop, according to the ancient and traditional Pontifical Rite in use in The Apostolic Church of the Pleroma, and recognize him in the name, in ecclesia, of

Given from Us, under Our Signature, in the thirteenth year of our episcopate, on the day of the consecration, the Eleventh day of December, in the Two Thousand Fourteenth Year of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, the 125th year of the Gnosis Restored, AMEN.
