## Liturgy of St. Peter the Gnostic

The role of St. Peter within Gnostic scriptures and sects has often been as a stand-in for the psychic Church, that is, the non-Gnostic, so-called "orthodoxy." Within certain Gnostic texts, such as the Pistis Sophia, and the Gospel of Thomas, Peter is depicted as ignorant of, and even outright hostile toward, the higher pneumatic teachings. And, while this may be a useful literary device by which to criticize the purely psychic interpretation of Christ, it is by no means the final word on the matter.

Among the Gnostic writings are a number of pieces which portray Peter as a recipient and transmitter of Gnostic teachings and revelations, most notably the Apocalypse of Peter and the Letter of Peter to Philip, and to a lesser extent the Acts of Peter and the Twelve, works which appear all in the Nag Hammadi Codices. And within the canonical texts, the Second Epistle of Peter is of a particularly mystical, and I would go so far as to say gnostic, treatise (cf. our "Theosis Through Gnosis" at pleromachurch.org). And, as modern Gnostics who hold and value the Apostolic Succession which emits principally from St. Peter, it seems wise to do a little to rehabilitate his name, and to bring to light the deeply pneumatic teachings of the Petrine tradition.

Therefore, we have arranged the following liturgy which, while following the basic format of our principal Liturgy of the Pleromic Light, incorporates aspects of the aforesaid Petrine tradition. This is done in two manners: lst, by incorporating text from the canonical Petrine epistles, as well as from the specifically Petrine works from the Nag Hammadi Codices; 2nd, by incorporating the Latin text of certain aspects of the Mass, so as to invoke a connection with the ancient Roman Church, being a principal expression of the Petrine tradition. The Latin text is drawn primarily from that given by Abbé Julio in Liturgical Prayers, wherein also its translation may be found. In the case of the small Latin excerpt from 2 Peter, it has been taken from the Nova Vulgata, Ed. XXVII.

As with our other alternate liturgies, the present work is not intended to replace the Holy Gnostic Liturgy of the Pleromic Light, but to supplement it. In the future we may have specific recommendations as to particular feast days to which this Mass is especially suited, but for now we simply encourage our priests and friends of the Church to experiment with it and inform us of their experiences with it.

The layout of the Temple is the same as that used for our standard Mass, with the following exceptions:

Read Altar: Draped in red; icon (s) of St. Peter.

Eucharistic Altar: Draped in white, with Cross of St. Peter in red; Cross of St. Peter may be displayed as Altar Cross as well.

1st Deacon's lectern: Draped in red, with Cross of St. Peter in black.

2nd Deacon's lectern: Draped in black, with Cross of St. Peter in white.

All other items as usual.

The Preliminary Rites and Procession are the same as found in the standard liturgy, and therefore are not reproduced here. Likewise, the Recession is as described in *The Pleromic Light Unveiled*.

# Breaking of the Bread

#### PRIEST:

O Divine Light, You show Yourself this day upon countless altars and yet are one and indivisible. In token of Thy great Sacrifice, we rend (break bread) this, Thy Holy Body, that we may be as Thou art.

Through this ancient and sacred tradition, all Heaven and Earth are united in Thy Consciouness, Thy Love, and Thy Will. And as the One became many, only to restore all to the Pleroma, so too, in the breaking of this bread, we are one with Thee, as Thou art one with the Father.

Breaks off small piece of bread from the left half, makes sign of the cross over the Chalice, and places piece in Chalice; then blows three crosses of air over the Chalice.

Hæc commixtio et consecratio Corporis et Sanguinis Domini nostri Jesu Christi fiat accipientibus nobis in vitam æternam. Amen.

Intones...

Through Him, and with Him, and in Him; In the Unity of the Holy Spirit; All glory and honor are Yours Almighty Father, Forever and ever.

ALL: (intones)

Amen.

### PRIEST:

Let us pray. Adoration be to Thee, O Most High God, Father of all Fatherhood, and to Thee, O Mother of all, who in the incarnation of Your Logos have mystically provided us with the Sacrament of His Body and Blood, that by partaking of this

Mystery, we may reunite within ourselves the fragments of Your Divinity dispersed throughout the Cosmos. Holy, Holy, Holy, are You, the Father and Mother of the Treasury of the Light, now and unto the countless ages. Amen.

## Theurgic Consecration

- Priest takes Dagger, faces East, and draws the letter YOD in the air with Dagger as it is pronounced, then intones the Holy Name, thus:
- By the virtue of <sup>5</sup> I call forth the power of IAO to join in this Holy Sacrifice.

  Priest travels to the South via the North and West, that is, by walking
  270° counter-clockwise, draws the letter HF, and intones the Holy Name, thus;
- By the virtue of \int I call forth the power of SABAOTH to join in this Holy Sacrifice.

  Priest continues 270° counter-clockwise to the West, draws the letter VAV,
  and intones the Holy Name, thus:
- By the virtue of 1 I call forth the power of ABRAXAS to join in this Holy Sacrifice.

  Priest continues 270° to the North, draws the letter HF, and intones the
  Holy Name, thus:
- By the virtue of \(\) I call forth the power of SOPHIA to join in this Holy Sacrifice.

  Priest travels 270° counter-clockwise again to return to the East for the third complete circuit. he faces the Eucharistic Altar, and with arms outstretched and holding the Dagger in the right hand...

The Son would not be the Father without wearing the Father's Name. So by the Power of the Holy Tetragrammaton, and by the virtue of the Tri-Uniity of the Holy Letter (draws Hebrew letter with Dagger in the air above Chalice), I call forth the power of the Author of Regeneration, the Repairer of Souls, the Destroyer of Death...

Intones while slowly lowering Dagger with both hands into Chalice.

This to pour forth Thy powers into this Holy Sacrifice and transmute these elements of bread and wine into the Divine Body and Blood of the Logos.

Makes three crosses in Chalice with Dagger.

Then, arms outstretched, palms up, chant...

Et habemus firmiorem propheticum sermonem, cui bene factis attendentes quasi lucernæ lucenti in caliginoso loco, donec dies illucescat, et Lucifer oriatur in cordibus vestris.

#### Communion

PRIEST: (Elevating the Body and Blood)

Behold the Divine Light which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. May the communion of these Holy Mysteries be to the regeneration of both soul and body. Let us draw nigh and receive this most Holy Sacrament.

After the communion has been administered...

### First Ablution

PRIEST: (Pours a little wine & water into Chalice) Quod ore sumpsimus. Domine, pura mente capiamus: et de munere temporali fiat nobis remedium sempiternum.

Drinks.

### Second Ablution

PRIEST: (Joins thumbs & forefingers over the Chalice & has Acolyte or other assistant pour some water only over them into the Chalice)

### Dismissal

### PRIEST:

Be strong, for these mysteries have been given to you so that you might know through a revelation that the one they crucified is the firstborn, the abode of demons, the stone vessel in which they live, the man of Elohim, the man of the cross, who is under the law. But the one who is standing near him is the living Savior, who was in him at first, and was arrested but set free. He is laughing at their lack of perception, knowing that they were born blind. The one capable of suffering must remain, since the body is the substitute, but what was set free was the bodiless body, the Spirit of Thought filled with radiant light.

Present what you have seen to those who are strangers, who are not of this aeon. For there will be no grace among those who are not immortal, but only among those elect because of their immortal nature, which has shown it can receive the one who gives in abundance.

For this reason it is said, Whoever has will be given more, and shall have it abundantly. But whoever has not - that is to say the man of this aeon who completely is as one who is dead, who derives from creation and procreation, who thinks he can lay hold of someone else of immortal nature when such a person appears - this will be taken away from that person and added to whatever exists.

So be courageous and fear nothing. For אונים shall be with you, that none of your enemies may prevail over you.

May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knolwedge of God and our Lord אָרָבָּוֹלָוּלָיִי, Pax Vobis.
